Porteño Malbec, Bodega Norton, 2017 6.95 9.95

Mendoza, Argentina

Rich dusky red in colour. Sweet and spacious aromas reminding of black pepper. Fruity on the palate, with sweet and harmonious tannins.

MadFish Pinot Noir 2016, Western Australia 7.20 11.00

Rose, cherry and spice on the nose, vibrant fruit with underlying savoury mushroom notes on the palate. This wine has a silky texture, a fine thread of acidity and soft mouth filling tannins.

Carmenère Reserva, Casa Silva, 2016 8.20 11.60

Colchagua Valley, Chile

Carmenère has survived emigration (from Bordeaux), disease (the vine plague phylloxera) and misidentification (much Chilean “Merlot” is actually Carmenère) to find a home as Chile’s signature grape - this juicy blackberry example is full yet soft.

Château Baron Bellevue, Côtes de Bourg, 8.60 12.50

2012, Bordeaux, France

Classic Cote de Bourg: gutsy, spicy and very approachable. Mainly Merlot, this is typically ripe and spicy with wild bramble flavours, tasty tannins and a lovely gutsy character.

Chianti Superiore, Santa Cristina, 2015 8.80 12.55

Tuscany, Italy

A benchmark Chianti for nearly seventy years.

Bright aromas of apple and lemon peel with some minerality. Crisp, dry palate with vibrant fruit flavours.

Elegant, dry Pinot Grigio with apple and banana fruit aromas, floral lift in the mouth, and a clean, crisp finish.

Cervaro della Sala, Marchesi Antinori, Umbria **2015** **78.50**

Fantastically well balanced Chardonnay from Umbria – halfway between Florence and Rome

Spain

Albariño, ‘Sobre Lais’, Casal Caeiro, **2016** **42.50**

Rias Baixas, Galacia

A new classic from Galicia in north-western Spain, fresh and oaked but with a well textured palate coming from ageing “sobre lias” - on the yeast lees.

Germany

Weinhaus Ress Riesling, Balthasar Ress **2016** **34.00**

Rheingau

Crisp, medium-bodied dry Riesling, with lemon, lime and apple fruit flavours, a floral lift and a clean finish.

Southern Hemisphere

Chardonnay, First Fleet, **2017** **23.50**

South Eastern Australia

A crispy modern Chardonnay with red apple and melon fruit filling a palate that is dry yet well rounded.

Sauvignon Blanc, Featherdrop Hill, **2017** **33.00`**

Malborough, New Zealand

Classic Marlborough style with zesty citrus and gooseberry flavours but with twist of fresh mint and minerality on the finish.

Stellenbosch, South Africa

Rich, layered with dried apricot, vanilla and honey ...dont ask what FMC stands for!

Santa Alegria Cabernet Sauvignon/Syrah Rosé, 2017 22.50
Valle Central, Chile

Dry, full-flavoured Chilean rosé, combining the juicy berry fruit of Cabernet Sauvignon with the spicy freshness of Syrah.

Cotes de Provence Rose, Carte Noire 2017 36.50
Les Maitres Vignerons de St-Tropez, France

Very refined dry rosé, with an attractive floral aroma, redcurrant fruit, and excellent length on the palate.

Red Wine

Big Guns

Réserve D'Angludet, Château D'Angludet, 2015 75.00
Margaux, Bordeaux

The Legendary Peter Sichel spent forty years driving up the quality of this estate, classically styled Bordeaux showing fleshy and warm notes on the palate. Smooth with balanced oak and a fine finish.

Gevrey-Chambertin, Domaine Perrot-Minot, 2011 92.60
Côte d'Or, Burgundy, France

Minimal oak allows the red fruit and exotic spices to shine through.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape Boisrenard, 2013 82.50
Beaurenard, Rhone Valley, France

From the oldest vines on the Beaurenard Estate comes this dense, inky, hugely concentrated mouthful of blackberry fruit. Fresher than so many luxury cuvées.

Réserve de la Comtesse, Château Pichon, 2008 85.00
Pauillac, Bordeaux

Classic Pauillac blackcurrant and cedar, but the big dash of Merlot in this wine makes it approachable at a young age.

Costasera Amarone della Valpolicella, Masi, 2012 83.00
Veneto, Italy

Bright and intense on the nose with aromas of preserved cherries and dried plums together with hints of fruits of the forest and cinnamon. Good weight from the alcohol and structured on the palate, opening out to attractive aromas of cherries and vanilla. Long, velvety finish.

Ridge Geyserville Zinfandel, Sanoma County, 2015 89.95
California, USA

This wine is fermented entirely by native yeasts, creating a true representation of the vineyard's character, which offers inky blackberry, blueberry, plum and cedar, with a superb structure.

Gernot Langes, Bodega Norton, Luján de Cuyo 2010 98.00
Mendoza, Argentina

Norton's flagship wine is a selection of their very best vineyard parcels of Malbec, Cab. Sauv and Cab. Franc. It shows great depth on the nose, with dark, brooding aromas of toast, mocha and rich black fruit. The palate is dense and opulent, with impressive concentration of fruit and yet a deftly woven structure, leading to spicy complexity on the finish.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Joseph Phelps 2013 110.00
Napa Valley, California, USA

A cooler year in Napa gives a more elegant wine, with complex layers of chocolate and spice balancing out the luxurious Californian ripeness.

Nuits-Saint-Georges Vielle Vignes, 2012 115.00
Alain Michelot, Côte d'Or, Burgundy

Sleek, aromatic burgundy with the typical blackberry and spice character of Nuits. Full in the mouth yet beautifully poised, this wine shows the depth and precision that come from old vines.

Tignanello, Marchese Antinori, Tuscany, Italy 2014 125.00

The original super Tuscan, with a drop of French style (in the form of 20% Cabernet Sauvignon and high quality oak) adding polish to the Tuscan tradition and the meaty Sangiovese.

Château Kirwan, Margaux, Bordeaux 2012 125.00

One of the best loved third growths in the Médoc, originally owned by Sir John Collingwood it has been under the stewardship of the Schyler family since 1925. A classic medium-bodied Margaux, showing good aromatic depth of red fruit and smoke with a fresh and succulent palate.

France

Cuvée 21 Rouge, Georges Duboeuf, Pays d'Oc NV 19.95

A bistro classic and the 21 Hospitality house wine for nearly 30 years.

Terres d'Azur Merlot, Vin Pays d'Oc 2017 24.00

Rich berry and plum aromas with hints of spice and chocolate lead on to a soft, smooth palate with generous fruit and smoky notes.

Ventoux, Delas et Frères, Rhône Valley 2015 31.00

Rounded and fruit-driven, with ripe red berries on the nose, and a plump, juicy palate.

Château Baron Bellevue, Côtes de Bourg, Bordeaux 2012 36.00

Classic Cote de Bourg: gutsy, spicy and very approachable. Mainly Merlot, this is typically ripe and spicy with wild bramble flavours, tasty tannins and a lovely gutsy character.

Malbec, Cahors Tradition, Château Haut Monplaisir, South West France 2015 37.00

The original Malbec, dark and rich but more savoury and structured than the Argentine version.

Fleurie, La Madonne, Georges Duboeuf, Beaujolais 2015 42.00

This famous Cru lives up to its name with a smooth, elegant and –yes – floral wine of immense charm.

Italy

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Poggio Anima, 2015 26.95
Abruzzo

Glass-staining ruby. Black cherry, liquorice and plum jam on the nose, with big, ripe and expansive, showing an element of warmth to the very sweet dark berry liqueur flavours.

Salice Salentina Riserva, Ducale, Puglia 2014 27.30

A classic wine from the south of Italy, this Salice Salentino offers deliciously harmonious mature fruit, with notes of black cherry, raisins and leather.

Nero d'Avola, Feudo Arancio, Sicily 2015 28.50

Deep garnet with crimson highlights. Pleasant nose of cherry and redcurrant with a vegetal note. Supple attack, suave, robust and consistent palate.

Chianti Superiore, Santa Cristina, Tuscany 2015 37.60

A benchmark Chianti for nearly seventy years.

Barbera d'Asti Fiulot, Prunotto, Piedmont 2017 35.65

Fragrant on the nose with hints of plum and cherry. On the palate it is well structured and soft, showing the typical red fruit and bright character of the Barbera variety.

Il Velluto, Valpolicella Classico, Meroni, Veneto 2015 42.00

Classic Valpolicella, juicy and refreshing cherry fruit and light enough for oily fish as well as pork and poultry.

Nebbiolo 'Costa Bassa', Sandro Fay, Valtellina, 2017 59.90
Superiore, Valgella, Lombardia

Costa Bassa Fay has a superbly vibrant colour entices you in and leads to a complex nose of fruits and flowers; dog rose and raspberries with touches of spice.

Spain

Casa Bonita Malbec, Castilla-la-Mancha, Spain 2015 26.75

Packed full of ripe fruit from the sunshine of the Spanish plains.

Garnacha, Finca Antigua, La Mancha 2013 29.60

High aromatic intensity with initial hints of mineral, violets and ripe red berries. Notes of Indian ink and subtle nuances of new oak, tobacco and breadcrumbs. In the mouth, a silky attack, fresh with a velvety, full mouthfeel.

Riberal Ribera del Duero Roble, Bodegas Santa Eulalia 2016 32.50

Elegant strawberry and blackcurrant fruit has been given the merest hint of vanilla and spice from a short spell in oak. Smooth and powerful on the palate, with an elegantly appetising finish.

Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Luis Alegre 2014 34.50

Light garnet colour on the eye. A mix of cherry and red fruits with mineral tones on the palate. Smooth mineral taste and elegant tannins with a long finish.

The Americas

Pacifico Sur Pinot Noir Reserva, San Antonio Valley, Chile 2016 26.50

Juicy, light bodied and a great choice to cover meat and fish dishes.

Adobe Merlot Reserva, Emilliana, Rapel Valley, Chile 2016 28.00

Generous red-fruit aromas such as strawberries and raspberries abound with touches of toast, vanilla and cocoa. This ripe and velvety Merlot has a lovely sweet and fruity palate aged lightly in French oak barrels to round out and develop the flavour.

Porteño Malbec, Bodega Norton, Mendoza, Argentina 2017 29.00

Rich dusky red in colour. Sweet and spacious aromas reminding of black pepper. Fruity on the palate, with sweet and harmonious tannins.

Passo Doble “Doppia Fermentazione” **2015** **33.60**
Masi, Tupungato, Argentina

Made from a blend of Argentinian Malbec and Italian Corvina, from dried grapes as in the Amarone method, full of New World fruit and Old World finesse.

Carmenère Reserva, Casa Silva, Colchagua **2016** **34.50**
Valley, Chile

Carmenère has survived emigration (from Bordeaux), disease (the vine plague phylloxera) and misidentification (much Chilean “Merlot” is actually Carmenère) to find a home as Chile’s signature grape - this juicy blackberry example is full yet soft.

Roble Los Horaldos Malbec, **2015** **38.00**
Mendoza, Argentina

A slightly lighter style of Malbec but still full of flavour.

Lost Angel Cabernet Sauvignon, California, USA **2016** **40.00**

Black cherry, currant and subtle almond aromas make way for rich, concentrated fruit flavours and a smooth texture in this classic style California Cabernet.

Los Vascos Grande Reserve, Cabernet **2013** **42.00**
Sauvignon, Colchagua Valley, Chile

A lesson in fine French crafting! Rich and complex but with finesse and elegance! The nose offers ripe berry fruit, a hint of pepper and brambles before a finely structured palate with smoky tannins and a huge finish.

Phantom, Zinfandel/Cab Sav/Petite Syrah, **2013** **59.00**
Bogle Vineyard, California, USA

Crisp and zesty, with appealing raspberry, spice aromas, easy-going cherry and roasted herb flavours.

Privada Malbec, Bodega Norton, Mendoza, **2014** **60.00**
Argentina

Excellent aromatic complexity with notes of ripe fruit, spices, and hints of smoke and coffee. Rich and generous on the palate with superb concentration.

Petit Verdot, Mini-Ediciones, Finca Decero, 2013 63.10

Valle Central, Argentina

This rare “mini edición” shows lifted jasmine, plum and berry aromas, spicy complexity on the muscular palate, and a degree of refinement and balance often spoken about but seldom seen in pure Petit Verdots.

Southern Hemisphere

Deakin Estate, Shiraz, Victoria, Australia 2017 27.00

Good punchy Shiraz aromas of mulberry and plum, supported by hints of vanilla and coffee oak. The palate is juicy, spicy and satisfying, with a rounded finish.

MadFish Pinot Noir, Western Australia 2016 33.00

Rose, cherry and spice on the nose, vibrant fruit with underlying savoury Mushroom notes on the palate. This wine has a silky texture, a fine thread of acidity and soft mouth filling tannins.

Mountadam Shiraz, Barossa Valley, South Australia 2015 35.50

The classic jammy fruit and peppery spice of Barossa Shiraz.

Angus the Bull Cabernet Sauvignon 2012 42.30

Aberdeen Wine Co, Victoria, Australia

Intense colour with bright purple hues. Ripe black fruits with rich dark chocolate and vanillin smoky oak aromas. Medium to full bodied palate weight, characterised by firm tannins and a savoury masculine finish.

Battle for Barossa, La Resistance 2015 45.50

**Grenache/Syrah/Mouvedre, Chaffey Bros,
Barossa Valley, Australia**

An Aussie take on Châteauneuf. Grenache driven GSM. Subtle seasoned oak and caramel lead to a deep-fruited, dark cherry and strawberry palate with supple fine grain tannin. Refreshing acidity gives delicious fruit through to a lingering finish.

Mount Holdsworth Pinot Noir, Wairarapa, New Zealand **2016** **46.50**

An exuberantly fruity Pinot Noir that offers bright strawberry and cherry aromas, as well as a finely etched medium-bodied palate of satisfying structure and length.

Katnook Estate Shiraz, Coonawarra, Australia **2013** **63.00**

From the legendary "red earth" cool climate soils of Coonawarra, this is a more elegant, crisp and peppery style - more Syrah than Shiraz.

Man o' War Dreadnought Syrah, Waiheke Island, New Zealand **2013** **72.00**

An abundance of sweet fruit, black pepper and savoury gamey notes which are typical of the style. The palate is elegant with supple fruit, vibrant acidity and a large presence of fine grained tannins emulating the structure of classical Northern Rhone.
